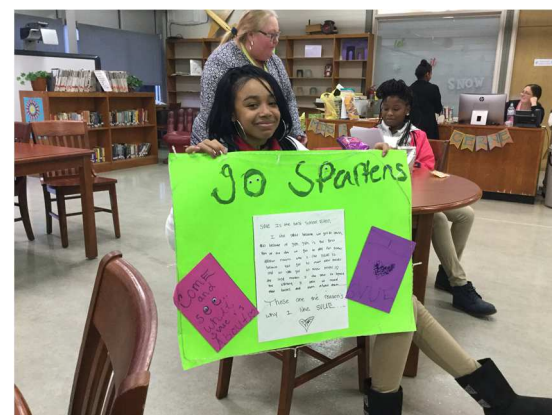
Students at SVUE were encouraged to write an essay on all of the things they loved about South View. Here are a few things they had to say...
